COMPULSORY ITEMS ARE NAVY

At least **ONE** of these outer garments:

Coat	OHS kagoul or plain, smart, black or navy winter coat . No other colour is acceptable. There should be no decoration on the coat.
Fleece	Oxford High School fleece only
Jacket	Quilted jacket (available from nearly new sales only); no leather or denim jackets
V-Necked Jumper or OHS Sweatshirt	Navy sweatshirt with sunflower logo
Skirt or Trousers (optional)	Kilt <u>or</u> inverted pleat (from Stevensons) Plain, navy, medium corduroy, straight-legged Wrangler style trousers can be obtained from a shop of choice, including Stevensons
Polo Shirt	Navy with school colour trim, short sleeved (summer) or long sleeved (winter)
Socks	Navy ankle-length, cotton mix <u>or</u> knee length, cotton mix (trainer socks NOT allowed)
Tights	Navy , opaque
Shoes, BLACK	With heel measuring a maximum of 4cm. Lace up shoes are preferred. No canvas shoes or trainers (trainers are for sport only).
Scarf, gloves	Navy scarf, navy gloves
Art/Science Overall	Blue, long sleeved cotton overall which can be fastened. The student's forename and surname should be embroidered in <u>large</u> gold letters <u>across the back</u> (or a gold t-shirt type marker pen may be used)
Sixth Form	Dress and appearance should be as stated in the Sixth Form Handbook

OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Shirt	Plain, white short-sleeved shirt may be worn in the Summer term only
Scarf	Navy scarf

SPORT

All sports items are to be clearly named on the outside (and inner surface) so that ownership is clear.

These are Compulsory Items: they all have the OHS logo (except the socks) and the school name

Midlayer	Navy with yellow inserts and white piping
Hockey Socks	Navy with yellow rollover
Swimsuit	Plain Navy
Swimcap	Plain Navy with OHS logo
Trainers	Without marking soles
Football Boots	Football boots are necessary for play on grass pitches.
Astro Turf boots	Team players will need astro boots for hockey matches.
Swim Squad match Top	For all pupils in the Swim squad
1st XI Hockey match top	For all pupils in the 1 st XI Hockey team
1st VII Netball match top	For all pupils in the 1 st VII Netball team
Kitbag	Any colour with name on the outside of the bag

Optional Items (all stocked by Stevensons)

Baselayer leggings	Navy with yellow Oxford High lettering
Leotard	Navy with yellow detail
Waterproof Storm Jacket	Navy with yellow inserts and white piping
Shorts	Navy with OHS logo
Tracksuit bottom	Navy with full leg zips
Gymnastic shorts	Navy lycra shorts for gymnastic performance

- All hair accessories must be in school colours (Y7-11)
- Make-up and nail varnish should not be worn to school (Y7-11)
