Oxford High School holds 'nearly new uniform' sales throughout each term (on Parents' Evenings), parents can check dates and times via the school calendar.
- **ALL ITEMS MUST BE NAMED (NAME TAPE OR MARKER INK) OR EMBROIDERED/MARKED WHERE REQUESTED FOR EASY IDENTIFICATION. Games kit should in addition be clearly named on the outside so ownership is clear.**

### COMPULSORY ITEMS ARE NAVY

At least **ONE** of these outer garments:

<b>Coat</b>	OHS kagoul or plain, smart, <b>black or navy winter coat</b> . No other colour is acceptable. There should be no decoration on the coat.
<b>Jacket</b>	Plain quilted jacket, navy; no leather or denim jackets
<b>V-Necked Jumper or OHS Sweatshirt</b>	Navy sweatshirt with sunflower logo
<b>Skirt or</b>	Kilt <u>or</u> inverted pleat (from Stevensons)
<b>Trousers (optional)</b>	Plain, navy, medium corduroy, straight-legged Wrangler style trousers can be obtained from a shop of choice, including Stevensons
<b>Polo Shirt</b>	Navy with school colour trim, short sleeved (summer) or long sleeved (winter)
<b>Socks</b>	Navy ankle-length, cotton mix <u>or</u> knee length, cotton mix (trainer socks <b>NOT</b> allowed)
<b>Tights</b>	<b>Navy</b> , opaque
<b>Shoes, BLACK</b>	With heel measuring a maximum of 4cm. Lace up shoes are preferred. No canvas shoes, no boots or trainers (trainers are for sport only)
<b>Scarf, gloves</b>	Navy scarf, navy gloves
<b>Art/Science Overall</b>	Blue, long sleeved cotton overall which can be fastened. The student's forename and surname should be embroidered in <u>large</u> gold letters <u>across the back</u> (or a gold t-shirt type marker pen may be used)
<b>Sixth Form</b>	Dress and appearance should be as stated in the Sixth Form Handbook

### OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL ITEMS

<b>Shirt</b>	Plain, white short-sleeved shirt may be worn in the Summer term only
<b>Scarf</b>	Navy scarf

## SPORT

All sports items are to be clearly named on the outside (and inner surface) so that ownership is clear.

These are Compulsory Items: they all have the OHS logo (except the socks) and the school name

<b>Skort</b>	Navy skirt with integral shorts
<b>Polo Shirt</b>	Navy with yellow inserts and white piping
<b>Midlayer</b>	Navy with yellow inserts and white piping
<b>Hockey Socks</b>	Navy with yellow rollover
<b>Swimsuit</b>	Plain navy
<b>Swimcap</b>	Plain navy with OHS logo
<b>Trainers</b>	Without marking soles
<b>Football Boots</b>	Football boots are necessary for play on grass pitches.
<b>Astro Turf boots</b>	Team players will need astro boots for hockey matches.
<b>Swim Squad match Top</b>	For all pupils in the Swim squad
<b>1<sup>st</sup> XI Hockey match top</b>	For all pupils in the 1 <sup>st</sup> XI Hockey team
<b>1<sup>st</sup> VII Netball match top</b>	For all pupils in the 1 <sup>st</sup> VII Netball team
<b>Kitbag</b>	Any colour with name on the outside of the bag

<b>Baselayer top</b>	Navy with yellow Oxford High lettering
<b>Baselayer leggings</b>	Navy with yellow Oxford High lettering
<b>Leotard</b>	Navy with yellow detail
<b>Waterproof Storm Jacket</b>	Navy with yellow inserts and white piping
<b>Shorts</b>	Navy with OHS logo
<b>Tracksuit bottom</b>	Navy with full leg zips
<b>Gymnastic shorts</b>	Navy lycra shorts for gymnastic performance
