

School Uniform 2022-2023

There is also a Stevensons shop in Summertown: 245 Banbury Road, Summertown, Oxford OX2 7HN, Oxford High School holds 'nearly new uniform' sales throughout each term (on Parents' Evenings). Parents can check dates and times via the school calendar.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE NAMED (NAME TAPE OR MARKER INK) OR EMBROIDERED/ MARKED WHERE REQUESTED FOR EASY IDENTIFICATION. Games kit should, in addition, be clearly named on the outside so ownership is clear.

We strongly recommend that students bring appropriate outer garments to school - such as sensible and non-branded coats. The school cannot be responsible for any items which go missing in school so we strongly recommend that pupils do not bring expensive coats to school.

Sixth Form Sixth Form students wear their own clothes rather than school uniform. We expect Sixth Formers to dress appropriately in a style that is suitable for teaching and learning, especially as they will be called on to guide prospective parents and other visitors to the school. This means that they need to be neat and tidy at all times.

MUSICIANS – FOR PERFORMANCES

Performers should wear a smart black blouse or top, and a black skirt and black tights. Formal black trousers (not leggings or jeans) or a black dress that meets the same criteria are also acceptable.

PE and Sport

All PE items are to be clearly named on the outside (and inner surface) so that ownership is clear. These are compulsory items: they all have the OHS logo (except the socks) and the school name

1st VII Netball Match Top	For all pupils in the 1st VII netball team

Body piercing and tattoos are not allowed as they have health & safety implications

We strongly recommend that students do not wear make-up and nail varnish to school.
