ALL ITEMS MUST BE NAMED (NAME TAPE OR MARKER INK) OR EMBROIDERED/ MARKED WHERE REQUESTED FOR EASY IDENTIFICATION. Games kit should, in addition, be clearly named on the <u>outside</u> so ownership is clear.

We strongly recommend that students bring appropriate outer garments to school - such as sensible and non-branded coats. The school cannot be responsible for any items which go missing in school so we strongly recommend that pupils do not bring expensive coats to school.

All PE items are to be clearly named on the outside (and inner surface) so that ownership is clear. These are compulsory items: they all have the OHS logo (except the socks) and the school name

Body piercing and tattoos are not allowed as they have health & safety implications We strongly recommend that students do not wear make-up and nail varnish to school.
