### Dropping off

- Families should ensure children are on time for school every day.
- A child arriving at the Prep site between 08:00-08:15 may wait in the playground where a member of staff is on duty. They should not be left unattended before the gate opens at 08:00. They will be able to enter the school at 08:15.
- Children arriving after 08:30 should enter through the main front door at each site. Prep children should sign in at the office.
- Parking on the Prep School site is limited to staff only.
- Please obey parking restrictions and drive slowly to keep children safe.

### Breakfast Club (NB - details about ASC - SuperClubs - are on P11)

- Breakfast Club is available from 07:30 to all the children and runs on both sites.
- Fruit, cereal, yoghurt and toast are available and children can arrive whenever is convenient for their families. However, food is only served until 08:00.
- Advanced booking is strongly recommended; a child whose parents do not pre-book are required to pay the marginally more expensive 'walk-up' rate.
- Breakfast Club (Pre-booked): £3.50
- Breakfast Club (Walk-up rate): £5.00
- Bookings should be made through the online booking system <u>parentpay</u>, although we will, of course, accommodate any child who needs to be looked after in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- At the end of Breakfast Club children at the Prep will be escorted to the playground at 08:00 until the doors into school open at 08:15.

#### Houses

- All girls belong to one of four houses:

- This system provides opportunities for vertical tutoring and peer mentoring
- Meetings take place every fortnight
- House events & competitions take place throughout the year
- Each house is led by a member of staff, supported by Year 6 House Captains
- Girls can earn house points, which are totaled up, and at the end of each term the winning house receives a special treat
